

Christians from different denominations and of different political persuasions are met together to pray for kids on Nauru, with vigils in Sydney, Melbourne and Adelaide.



Grandmothers greeted Daniel Webb from the Human Rights Law Centre (HRLC) outside the Federal Court in Melbourne on 2 Nov 2018, the day the Department of Home Affairs sought to argue that the federal court did not have jurisdiction to order that asylum seekers or refugees be brought to Australia.

The Federal Court has stymied the government's attempt to challenge its jurisdiction to order that sick asylum seekers and refugees be brought to Australia.

"For now, desperately unwell people being mistreated by the government on Manus or Nauru can still take their case to the federal court," HRLC director of legal advocacy Daniel Webb said.



<u>We Make a Stand</u> – **21 September – 6 November, Ballarat, Victoria** is a collaboration between refugee activist Wendy Bolger and Melbourne photographer Paul Dunn. *We Make a Stand*, is a critical response to the Australian Government's harsh border protection policy. Lake Wendouree foreshore becomes the site for this sculptural work. Trees are wrapped with images of people participating in refugee rallies, conveying messages which call for the dissolution of borders, and for the welcoming of refugees.

Wendy is involved in regional and national refugee advocacy activities. She has a Master of Arts from Federation University Ballarat. Paul has been documenting campaigns and public actions for refugee rights in Australia since 2003, and his work is in the National Library of Australia collection.
