## Manus Is. Centre Closure

The hundreds of men in limbo on Manus are desperate - we must not abandon them as Manus Island Detention centre is closed on Oct 31, and support is withdrawn.

\* Write to your local MP, Ministers and PM and local media regarding the men

being abandoned in PNG with the closure of the Manus Island Detention Centre on 31 October.

- \* Consider organising an action at your MP's office re this issue

# GETUP CAMPAIGN – new contractor for Nauru – Queensland based company - Canstruct

The Australian Government has struck an \$8 million taxpayer-funded contract with Canstruct taking to keep the offshore detention regime up and running on Nauru for the next six months, and we understand Dutton wants to see Canstruct detaining people on Nauru for three more years.

There are already 369 people, including children, imprisoned within the Nauru camp. Recently, Minister Dutton told the 900 men on Manus Island they could 'apply' to go to Nauru — shunting them from one prison island to another. Can you contact Canstruct and urge them to walk away from Dutton's deal and his cruel regime? To do so click here.

## REFUGEES DENIED PETS – the latest absurdity from Dept of Immigration and Border Protection.

As the Victorian Government is introducing reforms allowing every tenant to own a pet, people seeking asylum are being denied this basic freedom by having to ask permission from the Department. The opposition of the Greens, Labor and the Xenophon Team ensured it would not be supported in the senate, so it was not put to the vote. It shows the power of collaboration and advocacy and what we can achieve together. Thanks to all involved in raising concerns regarding this bill.

## OCTOBER 8 ACTIONS – BRING THE REFUGEES TO SAFETY



**Canberra** – an estimated 1500 people attended the Rally which got front page in the Canberra Times.

Following passing of a motion by the ACT Assembly calling on the Federal government to bring the people trapped on Manus Island and Nauru under Australia's offshore detention regime to Australia, the Canberra Refugee Action Committee organised for prominent members of the Canberra community including sitting MLAs and former MLAs who support this motion, leading church, union and sporting figures to lead the march on 8 October.
