As 2025 draws to a close, the Labor Government is emboldened, having passed critical legalisation with little resistance from a fractured Opposition.



This year there have been some positive developments for refugees and people seeking asylum, particularly for those who have been granted permanent visas after spending many years living on temporary visas. However, there are ongoing concerns about the continuation of offshore processing on Nauru, the abandonment of those remaining in PNG, and the ongoing visa insecurity of hundreds of people previously held offshore who currently have no prospect of being permanently resettled in Australia. With the support of the Opposition Labor legislated a draconian arrangement to pay-off Nauru to accept unwanted non-citizens from Australia, some of whom have served time for offences; there are well founded concerns about how those forcibly deported to Nauru will be received by the local community, and their longer-term prospects for safety and freedom.

You might like to use the AIDA principle in drafting your letter

- A Attention grab the recipient's attention. Say something positive about the reader that is directed towards the focus of your letter. Stimulate the recipient's curiosity
- o **I Interest** & **Information** encourage the recipient to read on.
- o **D Desire** Getting the reader to want to do what you are seeking in their interest to do so.
- o **A Action** inform the reader of the action you want them to take.

#### Suggested messages for Labor politicians:

Labor came to power promising "fairness" and protection for the vulnerable. But when it comes to the treatment of people with refugee status and other people seeking asylum it appears that a different set of values applies.

- The recent legislation to allow the forced deportation of supposedly "undesirable non-citizens" to Nauru not only denies those individuals basic human rights and natural justice, and degrades us as a nation, but also injures our already fragile relationship with our "Pacific Family".
- Nauru has long been the subject of colonial exploitation, and the Australia's use of Nauru as a
  dumping ground for vulnerable people and to 'offshore' our obligation to provide safety to
  people seeking asylum contravenes the values that Labor claims to hold.
- Australia has abandoned around 30 men in PNG, many of them desperately ill we need to show compassion and provide health care and a safe future to those who have no other resettlement option. They are not safe in PNG.
- All people seeking asylum should have work rights, the right to study, and basic income support while their claims for refugee protection are being assessed.

#### <u>Suggested messages for Greens and progressive Independents:</u>

- Thank you for advocating for fair policies and rights-based treatment of people seeking asylum and refugees. Please keep up your efforts in 2026.

#### Suggested messages for Liberal and National politicians:

- For too long the Coalition has denied people the right to seek asylum and have demonised refugees and people seeking our protection. I hope you will advocate within your party for the fair and decent treatment of refugees and people seeking asylum.
- Please also resist the demonisation of migrants modern Australia is home to people from all parts of the world, and this is a strength not a weakness of our society.
- Please stop the fear mongering it is destructive and unhelpful and incites hatred.
